When I speak I

- Stand on the spot
- Look at the class
- Work out what I shall say
- Speak clearly
- Speak loudly

When I listen I

- Look at the speaker
- Keep my hands in my lap
- Stay in my place
- Think of questions to ask

- Can I be heard?
- Do I listen to others?
- Can I be understood?
- Have I put my ideas in order?
- Can I expand or develop my ideas?
- How do I sound?
- How do I look?

- Do I like to listen to my friends when they talk to me?

- Do I give the teacher my full attention?
- Do I ask questions to have speakers explain their ideas more fully?
